OHIO'S FAIR SEASON IN FULL SWING & PLANNING FOR THE 100TH ANNIVESARY IS BUILDING

Ohio's agricultural fairs have seen good results with weather cooperating for the most part and as successes and concerns come from the fairs **Deb Hukill, Program Chairman** for the 100th Annual Convention is incorporating those ideas into workshop sessions.

Ohio Fairs' Queen Leah Schuhart has been to many County and Independent Fairs and spent 6 days at the Ohio State Fair participating in various activities. Reports indicate that food and ride grosses are holding up with retail sales lagging last year. Attendance, junior and open class entries seem on par with 2023. Concerns with security around groups of youth misbehaving, have shown up at multiple Ohio's Festivals and Fairs.

As we look past Labor Day and begin planning for the 100th Convention "MOVING FORWARD" the Registration Portal is open via ohiofairs.org for Fairs, Associate Service Members and Guests to purchase all items and services. The Friday January 3rd Celebration Evening in Hall A of the Convention Center will be transformed into a fairgrounds with Amusement Rides to "RIDE" Carnival Games with Prizes, a Barbecue Buffet served from 5-7, a Concert with the Fairgrounds backdrop by Jo Dee Messina and more fun. Doors open at 5pm with admission via your Registration Badge and the \$25 cover charge ticket that is ordered with your registration. More details on Page 3 of Chairman Kim Meyers report.

The Hyatt, Hilton and Sonesta Room reservation blocks are open and the **Drury Block** (reminder 6 rooms per fair only) will open mid morning **Thursday September 5**. Ohio's Fair members can now register and we have added a Guest tab for those who wish to purchase the Guest Activities separate of a fair registration. Registration for the Convention remains at \$50 till November 30 and then the late registration cost is \$80.



Preparation for 100-Year Anniversary Celebration Right on Schedule

If you like great entertainment, good food, and a venue within walking distance of the trade show and your hotels, then you will love the OFMA 100-Year Anniversary Celebration. What a great way to start the new year!

Planning for the big celebration is right on schedule and going well. The marquee evening is set for Friday, January 3, 2025 in Exhibit Hall A at the Columbus Convention Center. Exhibit Hall A is one of the newest and largest venues in Columbus. Doors Open a 5pm with the buffet. We are expecting a capacity crowd of approximately 2600 people to attend.

Reserved tables remain for sale and can be purchased ranging from \$200 to \$2500, and unreserved tables will be available at no cost. A limited number of the higher priced reserved tables will put you right next to the stage for the na-



tional country music act. The country artist that will perform is Jo Dee Messina at 8 PM . She has charted six number one singles on the Billboard Country Music Charts. She also has received honors from the Country Music Association and the Academy of Country Music. She has been nominated for several Grammy Awards. Her list of accomplishments also includes two platinum and three gold albums. She was the first female country artist to have three multiple-week number one songs from the same album. She is very well-known for her fantastic live shows.

At the Friday evening event, a delicious Western BBQ buffet, 5-7pm has been planned along with a cash bar. Amusement rides, games, prizes, and raffles have been planned.

Each convention registered person attending will be required to purchase a ticket "Cover Charge" for \$25. The ticket includes entertainment, the BBQ buffet, amusement rides, free games, and prizes awarded to Fair Boards and Associate Members.

Anniversary merchandise that will be available for purchase includes Jack Daniels Whiskey in a specially designed 100-year anniversary commemorative bottle. There will also be many clothing items available including polo shirts, t-shirts, hooded sweatshirts, and jackets. Other items being planned include hot and cold Stanley cups and glasses.

Free commemorative merchandise to be given away includes color changing stadium cups, handbags, and draw-string sportbacks. There are many other items under consideration and currently being designed. Details are also being finalized on the location and space that will be available for historical exhibits.


