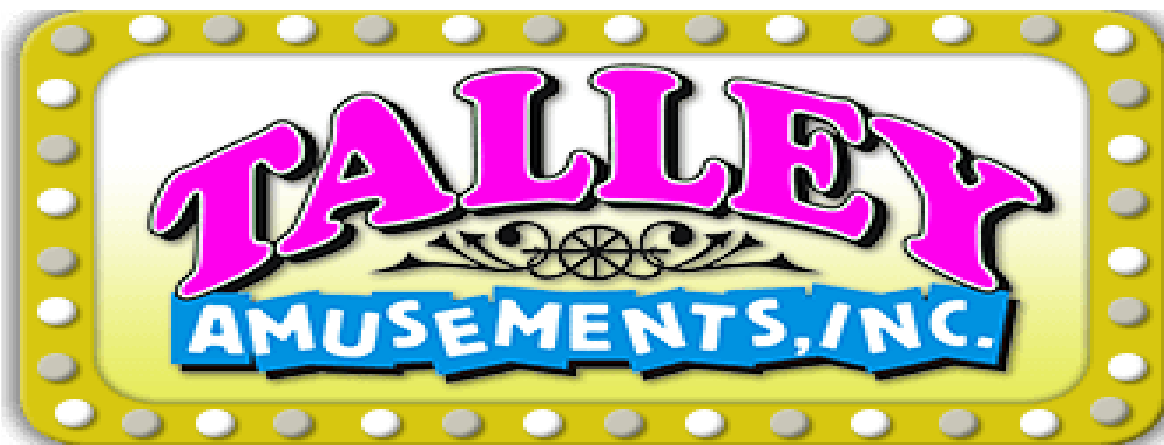

History of the Ohio Fair Mangers Association

Alfred Putnam Sandals was Ohio's eleventh Secretary of Agriculture. The Ohio State Fair helped organize the Ohio Fair Managers' Association (OFMA) around 1922 and **Myers Cooper** was the First President of the Ohio Fair Managers. During the early years, the OFMA's emphasis was largely on exhibitions of education and agriculture. Harness racing in Ohio began its growth in the late 1930s and after World War II the Ohio Harness industry grew rapidly and in the late 1950s the Ohio Fairs Fund was developed and approved by legislature to establish funding for racing and fairs.



The first convention took place in 1925 with convention programming expanding over two days with 12-15 workshops with several hundred in attendance, now fast forward to current day with the convention being four days, over 130 workshops, roundtables, and meetings with the attendance of over 3,500. The program ideas are generated from fellow fairs that demonstrate outstanding examples of how to enhance the experience we are all trying to achieve and have the fair goer experience. These programs are meant to help fair boards in attendance of the conference take back new and fresh ideas or give key tips to enhancing ideas already in place.

The Junior Fair participation which now averages 1,400 has grown over the years and educational programming is designed with the assistance of The Ohio State University Extension staff of specialists.

Over the years as the attendance continued to grow, it was in 1985, Executive Secretary Mark List introduced the tradeshow to the convention. It began in the Franklin Rooms growing to Union Rooms then finally to old Battelle Hall. In Battelle Hall there were game and food trailer manufacturers, an amusement ride, band performance stage trailer, and vendors selling out of their trailers along with tradeshow spaces. With renovations to Battelle Hall, the tradeshow was moved to the Franklin and Delaware Ballrooms and the hallways of the Hyatt meeting space. Mark started with roughly 30 spaces and has now grown into 165 spaces and the largest state association of fairs marketplace of tradeshow in the nation.

The conventions early on featured a grand ballroom banquet with a band for dancing, an extravagant plated served feast with the serving staff parade with flaming Baked Alaska dessert. Howard Call noted that in the late 1970s at the Sheraton Ballroom, "the flamboyant tuxedo clad head waiter during the flaming Baked Alaska parade dropped the huge platter leading the parade. He picked himself up, and we never saw the head waiter again". As time has progressed the fair boards like to go out to dinner as Columbus offers many fine dining locations and these evening banquets have faded away.

Today, the Ohio Fair Managers is the largest stated association of fairs conventions representing the 95 Agricultural ORC organized fairs in Ohio, including the Ohio State Fair, and more than 240 associate service members from allied fields will hold the 100th Annual Convention January 2-5, 2025, in Columbus, Ohio. Throughout the years, the OFMA has remained true to its purpose of promoting and encouraging the development and improvement of agricultural fairs, shows, and expositions. The OFMA is actively engaged and supports the International Association of Fairs and Expositions (IAFE) as well as the Federation of State and Provincial Association of Fairs.

The Organization Objectives are: 1. To represent and promote the general welfare of the County, Independent and State Fairs of the State of Ohio. 2. Encourage closer cooperation among Fairs of Ohio. 3. To promote Agriculture and its related fields to our fairs and their customers. 4. To provide for our annual meeting or convention of all Fairs, associated groups and businesses at least once a year. 5. To promote cooperation among all agricultural related educational and commodity organizations. 6. Follow the Established 990 Practice of the OFMA Board.

The Ohio Fair Mangers is proud to announce the induction of Conrad Haneberg, Medina County Fair

Conrad got his first taste of 'Fair' life as a 4-H member from a club in North Royalton. After his family moved to a farm in Medina, Conrad became a member of the Litchfield Friendly Workers 4-H Club. His main projects included showing beef projects, making knots and learning about electricity. Conrad demonstrated leadership skills by being a 4-H Camp Counselor, Jr. Fair-board member and being selected to Club Congress in Columbus. Being a part of FFA at Buckeye rounded out his high school years.

Conrad went on to Ohio Northern University and became a pharmacist. He married his high school sweetheart, Nancy, in 1968. Since his wife also grew up in 4-H it only made sense for them to become Jr. Leadership Advisors. During that role they chaperoned 5 and 9 year trips with teenagers. They settled on 50 acres in Litchfield where they raised cows, pigs, and four children, Gretchen, Lori, Carrie and Eric.

They continued in their father's footsteps joining the Litchfield Friendly Workers 4-H Club. Conrad and Nancy both became 4-H advisors. Conrad spent time constructing fair booths, helping his own children learn to show pigs, and being a taste tester for food and nutrition project recipes. When his children were old enough, Conrad assisted with Jr. Leader projects and with Jr. Fairboard. In 1989 Conrad became a Director for the Medina County Agricultural Society. He was appointed and accepted the position saying, 'I will do anything but chickens.' That anything has consisted of staying up all night to build a stage, hot afternoons placing Jersey barriers, cleaning the grandstand, setting up and taking down folding chairs for concerts, taking part in manure day after fair, parking campers for winter storage and manning a gate for Christmas lights.

While on the Board he has served as vice president from 2009-2012 and president from 2012-2015. Conrad has chaired and/or been a part of several committees over the years- Sr. Citizens' Day, Main Entertainment, Flower Department, Antiques Department, Director's Handbook and Constitutional Review. Conrad shines in his position as Chairman of the Outdoor Concessions Committee where he works with 120 concessionaires and the amusement ride company. He views all concessionaires as family.

Conrad and Nancy were frequent attendees on the Ohio Fair Managers Tours and Conrad has presented at the Ohio Fair Mangers Convention topics to share his knowledge of his years of experience on the Median County Fair Board.

The story of Paul E. Harris is one of dedication and an unwavering enthusiasm for agriculture and community. Born on October 24, 1966, Paul grew up on the Howard Family Farm in Bainbridge Township, a cornerstone of Geauga County's agricultural history. From the very beginning, Paul's life was intertwined with farming and the fair, a connection that shaped his legacy.

Paul often boasted that he never missed a single Great Geauga County Fair—not even as a baby. This early start set the tone for a lifetime of involvement. Vernon and Marion Howard, or as he called them Grandpa and Grandma, were his inspiration to lead a life dedicated to promoting agriculture and farming in Geauga County and beyond. Paul's parents, Ray and Jennie Harris, played pivotal roles in shaping his values. Ray instilled in Paul a strong work ethic and a passion for farming, while Jennie nurtured his love for community and service. Together, they provided the foundation upon which Paul built his remarkable life.



Growing up, Paul was actively involved in 4-H as a member of the Auburn Dairymen. He also participated in Junior Leaders and served on the Junior Fairboard, where he honed his leadership skills. His dedication extended beyond Geauga County. During his time at The Ohio State University, Paul traveled as part of the Buckeye Dairy Judging Team, showcasing his expertise on a national stage.

After graduating from The Ohio State University with a degree in Dairy Science, Paul dedicated himself to carrying forward his family's legacy. As a proud dairy farmer, maple syrup producer, and owner of Howard's Apples Farm Market, Paul was a familiar and respected figure in Geauga County. His apple stand was more than a business; it was a gathering place for the community.

Paul's love for family extended to his close friends Nancy and David Parker and their children, Evan, Becky, and Lauren. Evan was Paul's right-hand man on the farm, always ready to lend a hand with hard work and dedication. Becky played a vital role in making the farm market successful, while Lauren's sense of humor and laughter brought lightness and joy to Paul's life. Together, the Parker family shared a bond with Paul that went far beyond friendship—it was family in every sense of the word.

Paul proposed to his steadfast partner in life and work, Pam Krotzer in 1993. Together, they turned Howard's Apples into a thriving business and a symbol of their commitment to community and agriculture. This was never more evident than their Fall Fest expansion which involved transporting a 1950's Allan Herschell Little Dipper Rollercoaster to the farm. Watching families flock to enjoy Fall Fest each year, Paul would tout that they had the tallest and longest rollercoaster in Geauga County. Paul and Pam dreamed up new activities each year to add to the fun. Pam's support was integral to Paul's many accomplishments. They worked hand-in-hand in the barn, at the market and on the fairgrounds.

If there was one pursuit that matched his commitment to farming, it was the Great Geauga County Fair. Paul joined the Geauga County Agricultural Society in 1993 and quickly emerged as a key figure in the fair's success. He wasn't just a member of the board; he was its guiding force. Paul became president in 2006 and assumed the role of secretary in 2018. Through his leadership, foresight, and relentless efforts, he helped transform the fair into a model for others across the state.

In his role as Secretary of the Geauga County Fair Board, Paul was the backbone of the fair's operations. His meticulous attention to detail ensured that every event ran smoothly. Paul's ability to anticipate challenges and address them quickly and efficiently made him an invaluable asset to the fair. Often heard saying, "This isn't my first rodeo!" Paul managed even the busiest days with calm expertise. Despite his packed schedule, it wasn't uncommon to find someone at his desk, reminiscing about the fair's history. Paul valued these moments, believing deeply in honoring and appreciating the legacy that shaped the fair's enduring success.

One of Paul's achievements was leading projects to enhance the fairgrounds. From building the Bicentennial Bell structure to overseeing the construction of new facilities, Paul's vision transformed the fair into a state-of-the-art venue while preserving its historical charm. He never stopped working to make the fairgrounds a place of pride for the entire county to appreciate. In addition, Paul championed the Geauga County Fair Foundation, he worked tirelessly to ensure a solid financial future for his fair.

Paul believed that the heart of a fair was the junior fair youth. He never hesitated to support their efforts, whether it was through donations, guidance, or simply showing up to cheer them on. He believed in investing in the next generation, fostering their passion for agriculture, and creating opportunities for growth.

Paul's efforts were not confined to Geauga County. As the District 9 Director of the Ohio Fair Managers Association starting in 2008, and later as its president in 2022-2023, Paul's influence reached fairs across Ohio. He strived to ensure fair funding, promote legislative updates, Testified in the Ohio House of representatives on Legislation supporting fair recovery funding following the COVID shutdown and funds to maintain high standards for fair operations. His leadership helped countless fairs thrive and adapt to changing times. Again, Paul would put his own work on hold to coach another fair through any difficulty. He wanted the best for all those in the industry and worked tirelessly to ensure the future of county fairs in Ohio. One past ODA Director even mentioned that she thought Paul's passion for fairs was unmatched!

On June 4, 2024, Paul left us far too soon, but his legacy remains indelible.

The countless lives he touched, the traditions he upheld, and the innovations he championed will live on through the Great Geauga County Fair and beyond. Paul Harris was a man of integrity, innovation, and boundless energy. His story is one of devotion—to his family, his community, and the agricultural heritage he loved so deeply." "Paul, your legacy will continue to inspire us all. Thank you for a lifetime of service and love."

She has gone on several OFMA trips and brought back information she learned that was extremely helpful to our fair



Charlie helped start many programs in 4-H –Jr. Fair Market Steer Club-1980, Big Green Garage Sale-1990, and Tractor Certification-1999. She served on numerous advisory committees, fundraisers, FCS Committee, 4-H Committee, and many years as State Fair Judge and helper at both local and state levels. Charlie still is an active shooting sports instructor since 1992. She has been awarded 4-H Meritorious Service Award, 4-H Outstanding Advisor, and was inducted in the Ohio 4-H Hall of Fame in 2001.

Charlie was married to Wilmer for 44 years, mother of Jodi and Weslee, 5 grandchildren and recently became Great-Grandma. Her career included work as a meat cutter and mechanic. She also loves performing as “Babbette” who is known to take quick verbal jabs at attendees at banquets, meetings, and other events over the years and brings laughter throughout the room.

Charlie was a yearly member of the Ohio Fair Managers Tours and enjoyed the traveling to fairs and sights with the other Fair Board members. Occasionally Charlie would entertain the group with her comedy routine.

Charlie has been an asset to the Fair as well as the 4-H program and we are honored to have her as the Ashland County inductee to the OFMA Hall of Fame today

John and his wife, Rita, partnered to build a successful farming operation. While doing this, they encouraged their four children and grandchildren to be actively engaged in 4-H leadership and mentored many others who became leaders in various agriculture careers.

John and Rita's combined passion and dedication to the Fairfield County Fair is exemplified by the 2013 construction of Ricketts Family Hall located on the fairgrounds and the family's contribution to the 2024 purchase of both the Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Market Steers.

John and Rita were also active in the community. John was a member of the Fairfield Soil & Water Conservation Board for 23 years, Violet Township Trustee for 32 years, the Pickerington School Board 12 years, and a 65-year member of the Violet Grange. John and Rita were founding members of Epiphany Lutheran Church. Rita, who is joining us to accept John's award, is also a leader as the first woman mayor of Pickerington and recipient of the Athena Leadership Award from the Pickerington Chamber. At 93, she's one of the oldest members of our Ag Society and relishes her annual trip to the fair.

The Fairfield County Fair Board appreciates the selection of our longest serving Director for induction into the OFMA Hall of Fame.

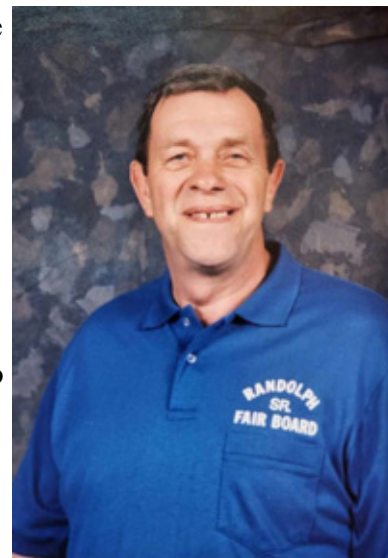

The Portage County Randolph Fair Nominates James ‘Jim’ May, Sr. for the Ohio Fairs Hall of Fame Distinguished Service Award. Jim has given over 80 years of dedicated service to the Randolph Fair. His love of the fair started when he was a teenager and grew stronger as he became a Fair Board Director in 1962. Upon retiring from the Fair Board after the 2020 fair season he continues to be involved as an Honorary Board Member at the age of 94.

Jim May has been involved with the Randolph Fair since the 1940’s when he showed livestock from his own family farm. As a teenager he would be on the grounds helping with whatever needed to be done. He held night watch and kept the fires going overnight as the Night Guard while he was in high school. In 1962 Jim accepted his nomination to be on the Fair Board and he became a great asset to the fair team. Jim met his wife, Faye, at the fair. They were married for 54 years and had six children; Mick, Jimmy, Peggy, David, Barbara, and Linda. Faye passed away in 2004. Jim was then married to Guinda “Sam” for 14 years before she passed in 2019. Jim has 14 grandchildren, 30 great grandchildren, and 2 great-great grandchildren.



Jim and Faye as well as all of their children and their spouses have been deeply involved with the Randolph Fair in some capacity throughout their lives. Jim and Faye were in charge of the ticket booths. Every year they would get the booths prepped for fair. Faye would then be a ticket seller. Jim was actually the first man to drive a tractor in the very first Randolph Fair Tractor Pulls contest in 1959. He continues to this day to be a large supporter of the fair’s tractor pulls and the way that the pulls have evolved. Jim’s daughter, Linda, recalls as a young girl sleeping on a bench until it was time to go home in the early morning hours after the tractor pulls were over. The family’s love of the fair has continued to be shown over the years as Jim’s son Jimmy is now in his 28th year as a Fair Board Director. Jim’s grandson Rick and granddaughter Christina have also been members of the Randolph Fair Board for quite a few years and granddaughter-in-law Jen is now the Fair Secretary. Sam was also highly involved with the Fair Auxiliary. The fair is truly a family event for Jim.

Jim took part in many aspects of the Randolph Fair and was definitely instrumental in the fair’s growth over the years. He helped build several of the first buildings, one of which still stands on the grounds today. In the late 1960’s, as a coach for the local youth baseball team, Jim and Faye hosted the first community concession tent on the fairgrounds. Jim also helped in the creation of the fair’s Demolition Derby and was very involved with the Derby and the track events for all of his years as Director. He played a part in our grandstand becoming the size it is today. His other passion was that for the draft horses. He was Superintendent of the Horse & Pony Pulls for many, many years as well as the Draft Horse Barn Assistant Superintendent with his brother, John May. Throughout the latter half of Jim’s 54 years on the Fair Board he held the title of “manure management” and he would be seen EVERY morning in the very early hours before the fair gates opened moving the piles of manure out of the fairgrounds. Jokingly, this was him being in charge of “everything that goes out.” Jim is and has always been a well-known Randolph/Suffield community member and has helped to promote and advertise the fair in the surrounding communities as well.

Upon Jim’s retirement from the Fair Board in 2020 he was “not allowed to turn in his keys” and became an Honorary Board member. He continued to manage the manure for another two years to teach grandson Rick the job. Jim’s birthday is on August 23rd, which more than not fell during fair week. In 2022 the Fair Board celebrated Jim with a cake for his 92nd birthday at the fair office. Jim was greeted by many friends and family on the grounds every day this year at the fair. He is now able to proudly sit and watch his great grandchildren show their own 4-H animals at the Randolph Fair.

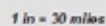
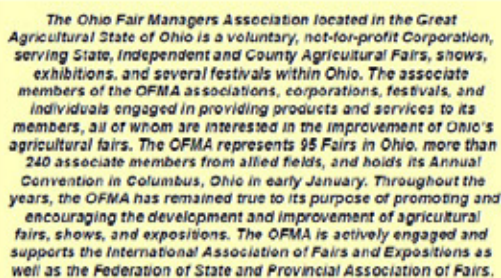
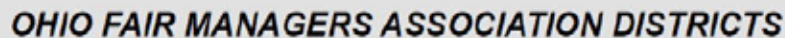
